In between the moment of meditation and the late news there was a station identification and a short weather summary.

As you can see by the above we were operating at 250 watts when you picked us up. We did not go to 1000 watts until 6:45AM CDST.

I am sorry that I do not have a coverage map to send you as we are in the process of having new ones made up and we do not have any of the old ones left.

Our regular frequency checks are conducted by Phelps Lab in Mpls and therefore he is able to measure our frequency during our regular broadcast day.
