Dear Mr. Wesolowski,

This is to verify the reception of our station on the 15th. of April, 1963. Every thing that you reported happened as you have it.

Please accept my apologies for not writing you sooner. I have been quite busy so have gotten behind in my correspondence.

We are now operating with 5kw of power. We used to be 1kw, but we received our increase around the first of this year, and we switched to 5kw around the 15th of March. We have an ITA transmitter, and our tower is 205 feet high. Our studios are located down town and the transmitter is about 2 miles out of town.

I am sorry, but we do not have a coverage map that we can send out. I do not have any regular testing schedule because all our frequency checks are made in Minneapolis, Minnesota, which is only 30 miles away, and they can be taken during the day.

Thank you for the fine letters, please let me know if I can be of any more help. That cup of coffee will taste good also.
