This is to confirm your reception of our signal on March 20, 1967 between 5:03 and 5:06 am cdt. The program portion that you heard is that of our station and is somewhat the same from day to day depending on the condition of our Farm Director who opens our programing in the morning.

Our facilities are as your described. Our transmitter is a Collins 20-V-3 and our antenna is a $\frac{1}{4}$ wave approximately 198 feet high.

Thank you for your report. It is suprising to find out occasionally that our signal does go out and is heard at distances far beyond our normal coverage.
