Thank you for your reception report of KIRL Radio on 5/31/74 which has been compared with the operating logs and found to be substantially correct, *EVEN THOUGH YOU ONLY REPORTED HEARING AN I.D. AT 6AM —*

KIRL is a 5000 watt daytime only AM station on 1460 kHz. Our programming is generally contemporary hit records and large selling hits of the past, together with local news and news from the ABC Contemporary Network. Operation is from 6:00AM to sunset with 5000 watts, using our auxilliary 1000 watt Raytheon transmitter.

Our main transmitter is a 5000 watt Collins 21E-1 transmitter into a three-tower directional antenna. Each tower is 170 feet high. The directional pattern is not too much different from the circle of a non-directional station, except that the center has been shifted somewhat to the south.

KIRL first went on the air in 1968, operating in the northwest St. Louis suburb of St. Charles, Missouri. Our normal coverage is roughly the eastern half of Missouri and the southwest quarter of Illinois. We have, however, been heard on occasion on both coasts of the United States, Canada, and in several foreign countries.

We appreciate and confirm your reception report, but regret that we do not have any regularly scheduled after-midnight frequency tests or the like.
