Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

I am pleased to confirm your reception of our signal on July 9, 1963.

KLIK is a 5000 watt, day time station, located in the capital city of Missouri. We operate from studios at 410 East Capital Avenue, four blocks east of the State Capitol building. Our transmitter is located west of the city and is an RCA BTA-5T transmitter shunt fed to a 243 foot guyed, uniform cross section, vertical tower. We operate non-directional and by remote control from our downtown studios.

This station signed on the air March 4, 1954, and has enjoyed good public acceptance in the area. For your further information, we have received DX reports from most of the 50 states and from as far away as New Zealand.

I hope this letter will serve as a confirmation of your reception.
