Hi Ernie,

It is a great pleasure to confirm your reception of KOKO radio during our special DX broadcast of Monday morning, January 21, 1974 between 2:00 and 2:30 A.M., CDST. Thank you for the tape, which I will return, along with another reel of yours that I have, when I see you again.

We did very well on the test, getting 23 reports from 12 states and Manitoba. The most distant were from about 1,000 miles, four of them; from David Thomas in Tampa, Fla., Tom Sundstrom in Willingboro, N. J., Kermit Geary in Walnutport, Pa., and Daryl Belanger in Swan River, Manitoba. The most reports were from Illinois (5), followed by four from Nebraska, three from Indiana, two from Ohio, and one apiece from Texas, Minnesota, Louisiana, Oklahoma, & Missouri; in addition to the four most distant ones. Thomas, Sundstrom and Geary got only CW IDs, while Belanger sent a good tape that had amazingly good audio. There'll be a complete list in the bulletin later.

I had the same results from KPCA and also tried again. No response, though. Probably won't answer at all this time. DX here has been slow, although I've been putting in more time now after a slack holiday period. Nothing spectacular heard, just trying to add to my veries. I've been chasing Radio Montserrat on 885, but can't get enough for a report so far.

Thanks again Ernie and I hope to see you this spring.
