from 6:29 PM to 6:45 PM Central Daylight Time on 800 KHz.

- 6:29 CDT MUSICAL JINGLE ID: "K R E I; the Sound of Farmington."
NEWSCAST with Howard Nobal. "Every 30 minutes, K R E I is 1st in Fact"
Weather Forecast. "41 degrees is the K R E I Radio Park Temperature."
6:33 Recorded music (complete loss-of-signal)
- 6:40 Talk by the announcer saying he will be back tomorrow at 3:30 and
the J.C.'s will be at the station tomorrow giving away many prizes.
- 6:40:45 Recorded music by Ray Charles
:44:30 SIGN-OFF ANNOUNCEMENT: "Licence Requirements make it necessary for
K R E I Radio in Farmington, to now leave the air. K R E I is owned
and operated by the Midwest Broadcasting Company, and operates on
the assigned frequency of 800 Khz. Some programs heard
K R E I will resume broadcasting services tomorrow at 6 am. This
is STEVE (last name ending in MAN) wishing everyone a good night."
6:45 CARRIER OFF.

This is only the 3rd time that I have heard KREI Radio. 1st back on 11/11/58
with sign-off at 4:45pm and on 11/30/58 with a Frequency Check at 1:45am. I did
not send a report then but wish to ask for a letter of verification for todays
report. Your signal was covered most of the time by KXIC and KQAD who both
signed off at 6:45pm with you. Farmington is on the Eastern edge of the 6:45pm
February Sunset Sign-off Time.
