5:59:30 SIGN-ON ANNOUNCEMENT: "This is ... for KRMS Radio. This is Tuesday, May the 5th and KRMS Radio, in Osage Beach, Missouri, This is KRMS operating on your dial at 1150 kcs., as duly authorized by the Federal Communications Commission, in Washington, D.C. Our power is 1000 watts, as we begin another beautiful day with music, news, and sports. We hope you have a wonderful day and that you continue to everyday."
6:00 Instrumental Theme music.
6:01 (You faded out as Station KSAL in Salina, Kansas came on the air.)

This is my second report to your station. The first was mailed to your Chief Engineer on the above date, but as of February 16, 1968, I have not received a reply. It is quite possible that my first letter was either lost or misplaced. May I please have a verification of reception, typed on your KRMS letterhead, stating the date & time of this report? Do you also have an extra COVERAGE MAP available?

I have been DXing for 9 years from Omaha with 981 verifications in my collection, which includes 46 from Missouri. I'm sorry that I have not heard your station since 1964! Thanks a million. Enclosed is a stamped addressed envelope. 73's.
