This will verify your reception report of KTTT on August 4, 1972. Your reception report is essentially correct. It was good to hear from someone in Omaha. Yours is our first report in some time.

We commenced 24 hour operation the 15th of March and have only been off for maintenance about twice since then. We have both a stand-by transmitter and a spare studio so unless there are antenna problems we seldom shut down. Our FM operates 24 hours also in stereo with an occasional Monday morning shut down for routine work. I'm glad we are to be included in your Missouri verified column.

The new AM here is KBUG, the bug part for the chief stockholder whose name is Bug. They operate daylight only with 500 watts and program the IGM automated music service.

Here's hoping you have continued success in your quest for the golden DX.
