Gentlemen:

I am pleased to report reception of your station on Sunday, October 6, 1963  
from 5:41 PM to 5:45 PM Central Standard Time on 1270 kcs.

Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

- 5:41 CST Recorded popular music.
- 5:43 Announcer ended his program.
- 5:44 Sign-Off Announcement: "At this time, Radio Station KUSN leaves the air to return tomorrow morning at 5:30. During our broadcast day, you have heard the very best in music, the latest of news, and have been kept informed in the late ... developments. KUSN operates on its assigned frequency of 1270 kcs., with a power of 1000 watts, as authorized by the Federal Communications Commission. KUSN is owned & operated by KUSN Corporation, with studios located on the third (or first) floor of the Howitt Building...."
- 5:45 Carrier off. (unable to copy the last part of above due to interference and fade.)

This is only the second time in almost five years of DXing, that I have been able to copy KUSN from my home, located only three miles from local KOIL-1290kcs. There is usually strong QRM from them as so much modulation with 5kws. This report makes St. Joseph 100% logged and I hope to make the same verified.

May I please have a verification of reception, typed on your KUSN Letterhead, stating the date & time of this report. Do you also have an extra COVERAGE MAP and one extra TOP 40 SURVEY available? I have visited your fine city many times, and have relatives living there, but I never did know the location of your transmitter. I did visit KKJO and the KFEG Transmitter sites, but never yours. Do you have a set Frequency Check time during the Testing Period? if so, what day and time? R/95%.

Receiver: National NC-183D 17 tubes. Signal strength: Meter S/5; unsteady

Antenna: Single wire, 100' long wire with one right angle.

Interference: Unknown, but may be KIHO Sioux Falls, S.D. or KFJZ in Ft. Worth, Tex

Temperature 87 degrees. Weather Clear and warm.
