This confirms your reception report of March 18, 1968 on 1340 Khz, at from 0400 to 0500 EST.

KCAP uses a Collins 20v3 transmitter at one kilowatt daytime and 250 watts night time. We are located in the Southwestern area of the Helena Valley and find that out in areas to the south our signal is attenuated to a considerable degree by the high mountains.

Thank you for your reception report. We were very happy to provide the test at the times requested by your club. It is interesting to discover how far beyond the normal coverage area our station can reach during the evening and early morning hours.

We would like to invite you to visit our facility at 9 North Last Chance Gulch if you are ever in the Capitol City.
