This is to confirm your reception of KLYQ at 1:36am,  
February 5, 1968.

For your information, KLYQ Radio is owned and operated by  
the Bitter Root Broadcasting Company, with studios at Hamilton,  
Montana, the county seat of Ravalli County in the heart of  
Western Montana's Bitter Root Valley.

KLYQ is a daytime-only station, operating daily from 6:00am  
till sunset with a "middle of the road" music format, both  
popular and western, along with news every hour on the half  
hour, as well as sports and weather.

KLYQ operates with 1,000 watts of power at 980kc's on the  
dial. Our operation is "remote", using primarily Gates  
Equipment fed into a Gates BC-1T transmitter which is series  
fed into a 185 foot "guyed" tower.

Frequency checks are made quarterly, to Northwest Monitoring  
Service, Pendelton, Oregon.
