Thank you for letting us know that you heard our station. Yes, we did transmit exactly as stated on your list which I signed and am sending back.

We are a Mexican owned station. Our call letters are X E V I P, we transmit at the A.M. frequency of 1560 at 10 K.W. We broadcast 18 hours a day and have a direct telephone line to C B S in New York, carrying all the C B S programs since we are an official C B S affiliate. Our audience amounts to some 400,000 people composed of bilingual Mexicans, Americans, Canadians, Australians, English, and European residents.

From time to time, about once a month, we get letters from people in the United States that let us know they heard us. We keep these letters on file and appreciate it when we are informed that we were heard. Thanks again,
