Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

Your report of reception of our station on Wednesday, December 12, 1973 has arrived here at our office. I am sorry that we have not answered you before; however, I do not find any evidence of having received your reception report here before. You mention that you heard on this broadcast that we opened the carrier with no modulation at 7:29 EST. And then at 7:29:50 went on with a Sign-On Announcement of "Good morning. This is WFGW in Black Mountain, N. C. Eastern Standard Time is 7:30." This is very possible; however, at your 7:30 point, you mention the ABC Network news. We do not carry the ABC Network news at a 7:30 point. Our ABC Network news on WFGW is aired at the top of the hour, so you could not have been receiving this portion of our programming. Our 7:30 programming, according to our program log dated 12-12-73, shows the Morning Chapel Hour with Wilbur Nelson from 7:30 until 8:00.

It is very possible that you have picked us up; however, we have been heard in your part of the country before.

I am enclosing coverage maps for both our AM affiliate, and our FM affiliate, WMIT. I trust this information will be of interest to you.
