Dear Erenst J. Wesolowski

Please accept this letter as verification of your reception of Radio Station KICX in McCook, Nebraska on March 5, 1967 at 12:48 to 1:00 AM Central Standard Time.

The programming which you heard at this time consisted of a 1000 cycle tone and identification for the purpose of a frequency check on the assigned frequency of 1360 Kcs.

On May 16, 1966 we changed our call letters from KWRV to KICX as you have mentioned. In fact I was the last one to operate KWRV on May 15, 1966. At this time the coverage map which you requested is not available. I can tell you that we serve the Southwest part of the state of Nebraska and the Northwest part of Kansas. In the area East of McCook we extend as far as Kearney.

The staff at KICX includes John Holm-news director, Dick Roessler-program director, Jerry Springer and myself as announcers.

I hope this letter will serve your purpose if not feel free to write again.
