Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

Please forgive me for only a brief reply. Everything is piling up as we approach opening day. That should be the last week of June.

We are on the air from 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon, and from about 1:00 pm to 5:00 p.m. daily. However, the signal is not modulated except for station breaks every half hour.

We have two towers, 119½ feet apart on a North-South meridian. The transmitter site is ½ mile West of the Western edge of the Nebraska City city limits (½ mile West of the cut-off, or straight West of Steinhart Park ½ mile). We're 500 watts, and have a coverage area that's primarily Northern. We pull in on the Southwest and Southeast to protect Superior, Nebraska, and Trenton, Missouri.
