Dear Mr. Wesolowski,

This will confirm your report of reception of KNEB on Sunday, September 9, 1962, from 1200 to 12:10 a.m. MST.

We were on the air at the time for a frequency measurement by Commercial Radio at Kansas City, Missouri.

Enclosed is a coverage map as you requested. This shows only our daytime pattern, however, not the night pattern which we were using at the time you heard us. Our night pattern is a figure-of-eight oriented to protect KMA in Shennandoah, Iowa, so our best night coverage is north and south. Our daytime power is 1000 watts and the nighttime power is 500 watts.

Kansas City hears us better on frequency checks with the night pattern, because the lobes are rather broad. The resulting signal in their direction is greater than with the day pattern in spite of the reduced power.
