Dear Ernest:

I received your reception report # 59-92 and am happy to say that it checks out with our program log of Sunday, April 12, 1959, from 7;45 till 8;00 am.

In answer to your questions, we sign on at 6;00 am Monday thru Saturday, and 7;00 am on Sundays. Sign-off time is usually 11;00 pm unless we have some special programming. We are lisenced for 24 hour operation. Our tower and studios are located at Sherman & Mary Streets, near the West end of Beatrice. We are lucky enough not to need a special frequency check at night, as the engineering department of KOIL can get our signal during the day. They usually check us between 6;00 and 10;00 am once per month.

A few other facts: We use a Collins 300J 250 watt transmitter, with a 159 ft Blau-Knox self-supporting tower. A ground system of 120 copper radials 310 ft long, and 120 radials 50 ft long. Studio equipment is RCA, Gates and Western Electric. We also have two-way remote pickup equipment in two cars at 60 watts and base station at 100 watts, GE, FM at 26.15 mc. We have no network affiliation except Nebr Sports network for University games, and do local sports quite extensively. Incidentally, June 12th this year is our 10th anniversary. Thanks again for your report, Id be happy to answer any other questions.
