I am pleased to report reception of your station on Tuesday, June 13, 1972
from 2:16 AM to 2:31 AM Eastern Daylight Time on 1380 kcs.

Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

2:16 EDT	1000 Cycle Test Tone
2:19	Audio Frequency slowly increased
2:21	1000 Cycle Test Tone
2:25	LOSS OF SIGNAL
2:26	1000 Cycle Test Tone
2:31	LOSS OF SIGNAL

This is my second tentative report to your station. The first, mailed to your Chief Engineer on the above date. As of August 20th, I have not received ~~me~~ a reply.

Would you please check your log (transmitter) and please acknowledge if you were, or were-not, on the air testing at this time. It may have been your monthly Frequency Measurement Check.

The signal that I heard was weak and under Station KWK in St. Louis, Mo.

In reading through your information in BROADCASTING YEARBOOK, I notice your station is owned by the "Pillar of Fire." Is this the same group that owns station KPOF-910 in Denver, Colorado? I can hear them many nights here in Omaha. Was it your FM station that was recently denied by the FCC, FOR application renewal?
