Thanks for you letter, letting us know here at KAMQ that you heard us in Omaha. I did mail a reply to your first letter you mentioned, but I assume that you did not receive it.

We are a class IV station 1000 watts daytime, and 250 watts at night non-directional. Our equipment which is new was manufactured in Omaha, by McMartin Industries, and so far we haven't had any problems with it since we signed KAMQ on the air in June of 1979. We are a new station, and have become number one in listenership in a three station market.
