Gentlemen:

I am pleased to report reception of your station on Saturday, October 16, 1971
from 12:11am to 12:15 am Mountain Daylight Time on 1340 kcs.

Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

1000 Cycle tone was heard between each STATION ID, which was repeated about every 30 seconds: "This is Radio Station KHAP, Aztec, New Mexico, on the air for a Frequency Measurement Check. This is KHAP, Aztec, N.M."

The above tone and ID were heard until 12:15am. This is the first time that I have heard your station under your new calls of KHAP Radio. My last logging was for your old call letters of KNDE on January 11, 1960 when on March 16, 1960, Mr. Jack D. Rhea signed my verification letter for that report. He was active in both the National Radio Club and the Newark News Radio Club. Do you know of him?

Interference: The usual QRM found on a Local Channel. Unknown.
