I am pleased to report reception of your station on Monday, March 27, 1967
from 1:36 AM to 1:46 AM Mountain Standard Time on 1400 kcs.

Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

- 1:36 MST 1000 cycle tone.
- 1:41:30 STATION ID: "This is Radio Station KTMM in Tucumcari, New Mexico, on the air for a Frequency Check." Repeated.
- 1:41:45 1000 cycle tone.
- 1:46 STATION ID: "This is a Frequency Check from KTMM in Tucumcari, New Mexico. This concludes this Test!"
- 1:46:10 OPEN CARRIER with no modulation.
- 1:46:30 Carrier off.

This is my second report to your station. The first was mailed to your Chief Engineer on the above date, but as of July 9th, I have not received a reply. It is quite possible that my first report was either lost or misplaced.

May I please have a verification of reception, typed on your KTMM letterhead, stating the date & time of this report? Do you also have an extra COVERAGE MAP available?
