Thank you for your reception report of WSUM during our special test on May 11, 1981. From the details you listed in your report this letter should serve as a Verification of Reception for WSUM.


During the first half hour of the test we operated WSUM with the Directional Antenna and then at 3:30 am switched to non-directional operation for the remainder. We played music, Voice ID's and Code ID's. The Code ID's were what made it for most of the reports that had a lot of other stations to listen through in order to hear WSUM.

WSUM operates with 500 watts on 1000Khz using a four tower directional Antenna system. The major radiation is in the NE Direction. The Format is Religious program as are our other five stations.
