Yes, 680 CHLO did operate with a day/night
power of 1 kw. and the same directional pattern
day/night.

Now 1570 CHLO operates with 10 kw. day/night
and a slight tilt of pattern north-westerly from
daytime orientation.

coverage. It is a compromised version of both day/night
patterns.
