Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

This is to confirm your reception of CKAR 1350 AM. We are a 10 KW daytime, 5 KW nighttime station with transmitter located in Courtice, Ontario. We have a five tower propagation system, three towers day, four night, with our main lobe east, west and north daytime, nulling the south. At night, we shift to a northeast direction with main lobe bearing 325° NE. Our main transmitter is of the plate modulation-high level type with a dead carrier high power of 10,224 watts at the common point.

CKAR was formerly CKLB (1978) and CKDO prior to that. We have been broadcasting for thirty-five years in the Oshawa/Durham area (east of Toronto) with an adult Contemporary format.
