Dear Ernest:

Thank you for your reception report of December 4, 1979 from Omaha. Yes, we were conducting a frequency check at the time specified in your report. The station was operating at 5,000 watts non-directional for the test and ID was given at 0102 EST. Oddly enough, our test tone was on for only about five minutes due to a problem in the transmitter modulator which tripped an overload at 0105 EST. After the overload was reset, it was too late for any further testing, so the transmitter was signed off.

I've enclosed some literature about our station which I hope will be helpful to you in your hobby of DXing.
