Thank you for your verification reports to our special test broadcast from 3:00 until 4:00 A.M. EST, December 29, 1975.

I simply do not have the facilities or time and staff to answer the many listening reports we received following our broadcast.

I did read each report and noted with great interest your location and reception conditions.

WBAN-AM broadcast daytime with one kw. The station is located in a town of 6,000 some 40 miles Southeast of Augusta, Georgia and 60 miles Southwest of Columbia, S. C.

We use an RCA-BT1 transmitter and have a fulltime companion FM facility.

Barnwell is near the EDA-Savannah River Plant and we have a developing nuclear industry. Allied-General has a half billion nuclear reprocessing plant under construction. Our 25 year experience with the peace-time development of atomic energy leads us to promote and encourage further development of nuclear energy. We have found it safe and clean and are convinced we should develop Atomic Energy with deliberate speed.

Thank you again for your reports and excuse this method of answering your letters. We were highly pleased with the response.
