Thank you for your letter of November 6th, reporting
the reception of CHAB Radio.

We have checked our station log and are pleased to
verify your reception of CHAB Radio at 12:00 MST, (which
would be 1:00 C.S.T. in Moose Jaw, and our sign off
at 1:10) on Monday November 6th, 1961.

CHAB operates on 800 kilocycles, at a power of 10,000
watts. Our transmitter is located in the heart of
southern Saskatchewan, seven miles west of Moose Jaw,
we also have three towers.

Thank you for writing, as we do appreciate hearing
that CHAB Radio is received at such distances.
