Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

I am very pleased to confirm your reception report of Friday, June 23rd, 1972. The report was correct, but we were not using a 2000 hz test tone. We used only a 1000 hz tone. The reason for the test was for a monthly modulation check. We normally operate with 100% modulation on negative peaks and 125% on positive peaks. We are a 250 watt non-directional station day time only, sunrise to sunset.

The local atmospheric conditions on the night of our test was as follows:

Temperature--70 degrees

Humidity-----70% saturation

Skies-----Partly cloudy

Our antenna system consists of a 273 foot series-fed tower. Our transmitter is a Gates BC-1G.

Thank you very much for your report. Enclosed is a coverage map of WIRJ-AM.
