
Just received your report of Nov. 21 re KMBL Radio 1450 Kc

You log is correct. On the third Tuesday of Each Month, we have
our frequency check with an authorized test agency. Our Freq.

test starts at 0500 and ends at 0515 AM WShen the signal faded,
that probably was the end of the test and the station goes off the air
until 0600 when the broadcast starts for the day.

It is somewhat unusual because at that time we broadcast at only 250
Watts. Thru the daylight hours we broadcast at 1000 W.

We have received report of logging KMBL at early morning hours from
New Jersey, Penn., New York, Calif, Oregon and Nevada. Yours
is the first report from Nebraska.
