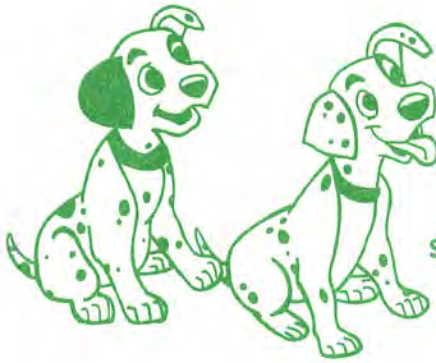

Dear Sir:

I wish to thank you for your reported reception of KINE Sunday, January 21, 1973. Sorry to delay in answering but wish to advise that we lost our AM tower since that date due to an ice storm. We have installed a new tower and are back in operation although for a few days we were operating on a wire antenna.

Yes you definitely heard our frequency check as we are on from 5:50 am until 6:00 am one Sunday morning a month usually the nearest Sunday to the 20th for a frequency check with Southwest Frequency Measurement, Inc. in Austin, Texas.

We are a 1 kw daytime station only and using a Gates BC1G transmitter with a 200 ft. series fed vertical radiator. Our studios are in Kingsville and our transmitter is located 2 miles north of Bishop, Texas. The headquarters of the famous King Ranch and A & J university is located at Kingsville.

I am enclosing a coverage map of KINE. Thanking you again for your reported reception.
