
Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

This is to verify your reception of KSET AM from 2225 to 2236 12/9/74. It is somewhat amazing to hear that KSET, a class IV station with 250 w night, could have any hope of reception in Omaha. Although I do recall getting a tape from Nebraska of KSET several years ago.

KSET shares a transmitter site with KELP AM that is located a few hundred yards from the Mexican border. I wonder if your reception of all El Paso AM's includes a new station KAMA. It is a daytimer with 10kw on 1060. However, it is spanish 100%, so you may confuse it with a Mexican station. Also, there is a new English station in the area XEROK. It used to be the old XELO on 800kc. Of course, at 150kw, it is easy pickin's.
