Dear Sir:

In regard to your letter of April 16, 1973, I can verify your reception of KTXJ on the morning of April 16, 1973 from 5:33 to 5:45 a. m. CST.

As I recall, I made only three ID's. One at the beginning of the check at 5:30 a. m., one at about 5:33 a. m. and at 5:45 a. m. Usually, I make ID's every three minutes but this particular morning, I was talking on the phone with the engineer that makes our measurement in Austin, Texas. We were checking the frequency direct in that my frequency monitor had gone out on me. Therefore, from about 5:33 a. m. to the end of the test, I broadcast a continual tone of 1000 cycles.

We make this test every third Monday as you reported at 5:30 a. m. CST. Also, at the same time, we make a test of the FM frequency check at 102.3 MC. We do not use a tone. The only ID comes at about 5:30 a. m. and at 5:45 a. m.

Thank you for your letter.
