Midland, Texas

Gentlemen:

I am pleased to report reception of your station on Monday, December 12, 1966  
from 12:30 AM to 12:40 AM Central Standard Time on 1600 kcs.

Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

12:30 CST Station ID: "This is KWEL, Midland, Texas, 1600Kcs., conducting a Frequency Check. This is KWEL, Midland, Texas, 1600Kcs., conducting a Frequency Check." 1000 Cycle tone.

The same ID's were given at the following times: 12:31, 12:32, 12:33:15, 12:35, 12:36, 12:37, 12:38, 12:39:30. Then at 12:40, there was either an open carrier without modulation, or the carrier went off!

This is my second report to your station. The first was mailed to your Chief Engineer on 12/12/66, but as of today, February 24th, I have not received a reply to my report. It is quite possible that my first letter was either lost or missplaced. Could you please type on your KWEL letterhead, a verification of reception, stating the date & time of this report? Do you also have an extra COVERAGE MAP available?

I have been DXing for 8 years and have logged about 1275 BCB stations, with almost 900 of them verified. From Texas I heard 108 stations with 55 verifications. Just two weeks ago KCRS-550 was heard during a special Test Program in the early morning. Many thanks for your interest. Enclosed is a stamped return envelope.
