This will confirm your DX report dated Monday, February 11, 1963.

KXOL is the top rated station in the Fort Worth area. Our programming consists of music and news. We play the top forty tunes and have news on the half hour and at :55.

KXOL is one of seven owned and operated by Mr. Wendell Mayes of Brownwood, Texas. The other stations in Texas are KCRS, Midland; KSNY, Snyder; WACO, Waco; KBWD, Brownwood, and KNOW in Austin. He also owns KTOK in Oklahoma City.

We operate with a power of 5000 watts daytime and 1000 watts night, and we're the only 24-hour operation in the city.

For your information, our AM transmitter is located at 5201 Bridges in the Northwest section of the city, in the vicinity of Carswell Air Force Base, and we have two towers at our AM transmitter site. We added an FM affiliation on December 15 of last year.
