Dear Ernest

Thank you for your report of November 18, 1963, reporting reception of KATI's frequency check at 1:31 am to 1:46 am MST. This letter will serve as verification that your report is accurate, and that you definitely received KATI's signals in Omaha that morning.

KATI is the number one station in Wyoming's number one market area, and reaches one-third of the states population. This may sound impressive at first, however Wyoming's total population is not much more than that of Omaha and Council Bluffs! Our transmitter is a Gates kilowatt, located about 3 miles NW of Casper. The tower is located on a hill overlooking the city and the mountain range to the south, and is 186' tall.

Since we began running weekly frequency checks (due to our frequency monitor being out of service right now) we have received reports from Illinois, Seattle, New Mexico, and of course Colorado. Thank you for your report.
