Thank you for your letter of 13 July 1973.

I am inclined to think that the station you heard while in the Sahara Desert was Nairobi, which also operates on 611 KHZ and has a power of 100 KW. compared with 2 KW. which is used by our station operating on that frequency. It is unlikely that with a power of 2 KW., we would be received so far afield.
