Dear David:

I doubt if you were listening to KFRB, as our program at the time you heard the signal was "Music To Dream By" which is a regular sunday night sign off feature. As a general rule we do not use vocals in this program, but on occasions we do, so it is still possible that you caught KFRB.

We have been on 900kc since last July, and since changing frequency, and increasing to 10,000 watts we have received mail from almost every corner of the United States. In almost every case we were heard on a sunday night, our time, between 10 and 12 midnight. In one instance our sister station in Anchorage, KFQD was also heard. KFQD is on 730kc. Might try us again the next monday morning, your time, that you are monitoring for stations.

Will be interested in hearing from you, should you manage to pick up our station. Thank you for your reception report.
