Your verification of a broadcast from WBHS, Huntsville, Alabama, October 28, 1932 was correct. That station was on the air approximately nine months. Incidentally, my employer, Mr. W. H. Pollard was chief engineer of that station.

In 1937 Mr. Pollard applied for and received his license to broadcast on the 1230 frequency using a new transmitter and the call letters were changed. The present call letters you will notice are the initials of W. H. "Buster" Pollard.

We have continued broadcasting since that time.

We are glad you enjoyed our comments on Huntsville and Monte Sano. From all indications we did very nicely with WNOR.
