Dear Mr. David F. Thomas:

Please accept this as verification of your reception of WJBY signals the morning of March 22, 1954. Your letter with its most enlightening comments and info is most welcome. Thank you for writing.

You evidently use a file system similar to the card file I use at my amateur station. You may complete your verification file now. 1941, 1945, and 1954. Finis. On March 23, 1954, all the equipment at WJBY and WJBY-FM was sold. Old WJBY ceased to exist at 10:31 PM when I cut the carrier for the last time. The license has been returned to the F.C.C.

The equipment will be set up in Anniston, Alabama, and operated under another call. The AM is a Collins 300J (which gave a great deal of trouble til I practically rebuilt it - hi). The FM a Federal 192A, main trouble being the 7C26 finals - changing to AmpereX 504R cured that.

I've been very pleased to rcve letters from Nebraska to Connecticut on our DX pgm. There are more letters uptown which I'll pick up tomorrow.

I'm taking it easy while waiting to go to a TV job in Montgomery, Ala. Lived here 25 years. at WJBY six years.
