We recieved your letter and listening report of reception of your station on Wednesday, June 24, 1953. It's good to know that our signal reaches so far.

We have a 500 watt RCA equipped station. It's located 3.5 miles south of Tuskegee on the Union Springs Highway (US 29). We have a non-directional antenna 305 feet high. We have been on the air since July 1, 1952, and are independant, daytime operation. Our 05. mv/m contour extends 42.5 miles but as you say, we are going out farther than that.
