Messages of appreciation were received by the Australian Broadcasting Commission from Borneo and Batavia, following the dramatic broadcasts from the National Stations 3AR (Melbourne) and 2CO (Corowa) early on the morning of October 24th. The Royal Dutch Douglas air liner which flew second in the MacRobertson International Air Race was in
