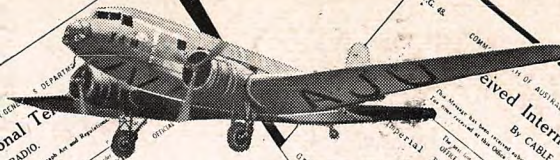

Messages of appreciation were received by the Australian Broadcasting Commission from Borneo and Batavia, following the dramatic broadcasts from the National Stations 3AR (Melbourne) and 2CO (Corowa) early on the morning of October 24th. The Royal Dutch Douglas air liner which flew second in the MacRobertson International Air Race was in

distress, East of Albany (N.S.W.) and information broadcast by 3AR and 2CO enabled her pilot to make a forced landing on the Albany racecourse. Thanks for this "aid from the air" was also relayed from The Hague by the Prime Minister of the Netherlands (Dr. Colyn).
