Dear Sir,

Many thanks for your letter and card of December 11th, 1947, directed to Regional Unit 5 RM, reporting reception of this Station's program. For your information we advise that 5 RM is purely a transmitter with power of 2.K.W. in antenna and 6.K.W. final stage, situated some eighty miles north-east of this city, its program source being provided by means of land-line from the studios of this Station, 5 DN, which has its transmitter of $\frac{1}{2}$ K.W., complete with antenna, situated on the premises which are located on the top of a twelve story building in the centre of Adelaide.

The portion of the program which you logged, has been checked, and coincides with your comments, it being a transcribed quarter-hour entitled "We Three", featuring female vocal, male patter and song, and piano accompaniment.

Enclosed herewith are verification cards for both transmitters, which you no doubt will wish to add to your collection.
