One hundred percent amplitude modulation with six decibels audio peak compression.

1510 Kilocycles plus or minus one hundred cycles.

ANTENNA:

Extensive radial ground system.

Top loaded vertical radiator, ninety five feet high.

LOCATION:

Swampy area near the beach. Two miles to the nearest high mountain.

RECEIVERS:

Two eighteen tube superhetrodynes operated in diversity.
