In regards to your DX report, I will verify it as being very accurate and as follows. We were running equipment tests on March 13th. as you stated. Even if you had interference, you still heard us and that is good enough for us. Thanks for letting us know that we were audible at least.

We have had DX reports from all over the world, the most recent one being from New Zealand, A Ken Mackey from Dunedin. The funny part about it is that we are only 250 watts. Our ground system is terrific. We have a river as our ground and it runs from north Arizona to south Arizona, the way it flows gives us almost a directional pattern to the west. Unbelievable as it may sound, thats what we have. We also have copper ore in the ground which gives us added coverage in this area. Clifton is the third richest copper producing mine in the world. Recieved a DX report from New Jersey and they say we come in fine with a little interference. The report came from Herbert Foster 59 Wallace St. Belleville New Jersey. I guess you want to know what equipment we have, well its collins 300-G-1 rig with a home made mixer. Our regular schedule is from 5:30 AM MST to 12 midnight.
