Dear Mr. Thomas:

Thank you for your interest in our Station, and your much appreciated listening report. We are happy to confirm same as 100% accurate.

Thought you would be interested to know that, at the time that you were listening to the Station, our transmission line was full of water, and shortly thereafter we were forced to leave the air (that is, our FM Station). We were off for about three weeks, pending receipt of new transmission line.

Possibly this explains the deep fade spots you mentioned on the FM Station.

In answer to your question about "KTKT-AM switch to 990 on your dial", we are increasing power and leaving our present frequency to go to 990 and 10,000 Watts before the end of the year, possibly in November.

Would appreciate any listening reports you might have on us after that time. We will be daytime only, so maybe Ohio is a little far to get a decent report. Would still like to know if you get anything.

Thanks again for the report.
