Dear Mr. Thomas:

Thanks very much for your letter of December 14th concerning our DX broadcast of the same date.

We were on the air with a DX program arranged by the National Radio Club, and I'm sorry to learn that you were unable to report reception of our signals.

We are using 250 watts Marconi transmitter using a vertical radiator about 90 feet high, loaded with a flat-top 90 feet long, giving us about a 1/16 th wave, worked against ground. Our modulation is Class B, high level.

Our signals have been heard on the east coast during the spring months, and you may be interested to know that they were reported S-4 at Vallejo, California on the morning of December 14.

I find that we were on the air with a DX program listed by the National Radio Club on February 19, 1946 using a frequency of 1230 kc, and am glad to confirm your reception of our signals at that time. About a year later, we switched frequency to give us better local coverage.

Better luck on our next transmissions whenever they happen to be, and in the meantime, Christmas Greetings and best wishes for the New Year.
