We began operations on the 17th of January 1947, with a new 250 watt Raytheon transmitter. Speech equipment is RCA and Raytheon. We use a 175 foot self-supporting tower located in reclaimed land of the Santa Maria River.

Out-of-State reports have come from Seattle; Ponca City, Okla.; Socorro, N. M.; Louisville; Washington D. C.; Belleville, N. J.; Walnutport, Penn.; and Coral Gables, Fla. Yours is the first report from Ohio.
