Thank you for your report and the comments on the reception of K D A Y in your area on the morning of November 26th, 1956 when a Special DX program was aired for members of various radio clubs all over the world. From the contents of your report I find that it checks with K D A Y's log at 12:15, 12:22 AM PST and other ID times on November 26th, 1956 and it is a pleasure to verify your report.

The delay in verifying reports was due to Mr. Dye and other members of the staff of K D A Y as they wished to make a concensus of the reports as they arrived on that particular DX program. They were very pleased with the results as we received over 60 reports to date from 22 states, Canada and New Zealand. In fact, 8 reports came in from N.Z. All of their reports show antennas of 500 to 1000 feet.....The furthest accurate report came from Howard Kemp of Laconia, New Hampshire.

Mr. Dye was quite interested in your technical report and wondered if you still used the equipment listed on your stationary. I also wonder about the same.

K D A Y's signals reached most of the area of the U.S.A. Reports from Mass., Conn., N.H., N.Y., N.J., Pa., N.C., and other Eastern and Mid-western states made Mr. Dye very happy. Thank you again for your report.
